



PICKAWAY COUNTY JUNIOR FAIR PRINCESS CONTEST RULES

1. Any youth organization participating at the Pickaway County Fair is eligible to have participants in the Junior Fair Princess Contest: 4-H clubs, FFA chapters, F.C.C.L.A. chapters, Scout troops, Farm Bureau, Grange, etc.
2. Contestants must be between 12 to 15 years of age by January 1 of the current year, and a member of one of the youth organizations participating at the fair.
3. As the winners will represent the Junior Fair, contestants are prohibited from engaging in poor behaviors including profanity, theft, smoking, alcohol, weapons, illegal substances, and inappropriate social media.
4. The completed application is to be submitted in-person, by mail or via email to Lemaster.158@osu.edu by **June 1**.
5. Judging will consist of a personal interview prior to the fair, and the application submitted.
6. The personal interview will take place the evening of **June 8** at the fairgrounds. Interviews will be conducted in-person. Contestants will be given an interview time when they submit their application.
7. The Junior Fair King/Queen contest will take place on Sunday, June 18 at 6:30 pm at the Amphitheater. The Junior Fair Princess will be formally introduced and crowned during the King/Queen contest. The selected Princess should meet by 6:15 pm at the Amphitheater. They will sit on stage with the previous year's royalty.
8. Appropriate dress for the personal interview will be business dress. The dress for the Junior Fair King/Queen contest during the fair will be nice dress-up; no formals please. All dresses and skirts are at least knee length. Remember you will be up on a stage.
9. The Princess is expected to wear their crown and sash around the fair to represent Pickaway County. They will also be asked to assist with the Queen/King during certain events throughout the week. Please remember you are representing our fair just as the Queen/King are. With this we ask you to wear appropriate attire throughout the week at events and to be a good role model.
10. The Junior Fair Princess reports to the current Junior Fair Queen and the Royalty Coordinator. All activities and invites post fair will come through or be approved by the Queen or Coordinator.
