Thank you for your interest in running for Pickaway County Equine Royalty. If chosen as the representative, you will have the opportunity to participate in parades and pass out ribbons and trophies at Horse Shows. At all times you will be expected to show good sportsmanship and serve as a mentor to exhibitors and their families.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS...

- 1. Ages 14 -18 years of age (as of Jan. 1)
- 2. A 4-H or FFA member in good standing and eligible for full participation at the Fair
- 3. A 4-H or FFA member at least one year prior to current year
- 4. No limit as to the number of candidates from the same 4-H club

EXPECTATIONS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE...

- 1. Assist at County Horse Shows (Pass Out Ribbons)
- 2. Attend community parades
- 3. Send thank you notes to all sponsors of the royal court contest
- 4. Attend 4-H club or FFA chapters functions (i.e.: meetings, work sessions, banquets) when invited

GENERAL INFORMATION...

- 1. Application must be completed only by the candidate. It may be neatly handwritten or typed. Contestant does not need to use the original Application Form; however, it must include all information in the same order that is on the original Application form. A fill-in application is also available on our website.
- 2. The candidate may only hold the position once. Once you are crowned Queen/King you cannot run again.
- 3. Horseless Horse project members are not eligible for this competition.
- 4. Criteria for the contest: a point system will be used with Horsemanship 50%; Essay 25%; and Interview 25%

TIMELINE:

- April 1 Application posted on-line at www.pickaway.osu.edu
- **May 31** Applications due to the Extension Office. Can be mailed or dropped off. Emailed applications to <u>sharp.5@osu.edu</u> will be accepted only if they are true scans. No photos of entries will be accepted.
- June 6 New: Interviews held in Heritage Hall prior to fair week starting at 6:00pm. Appropriate dress for the interview is business dress.
- June 17 Equine King/Queen Horsemanship class
- June 18 Announcement of King & Queen at approximately noon during Tuesday Horse Show (must be present)
