Items of Note:

- ❖ Exhibitors must choose a “seat” within each discipline at the same show, ie: with Western discipline, exhibitors must choose between Western vs. Ranch. The seat will follow the horse, not the rider.
- ❖ The same horse cannot show in both:
 - Western Pleasure and Ranch Pleasure
 - Western pleasure and Reining
 - Trail and Trail-in-hand
 - Halter and Miniature Horse Halter
- ❖ If a horse shows in crossrails, they may not show in vertical/2’0” or 2’3”
- ❖ Walk, Trot classes are about the horse and/or the rider. Any horse shown in a Walk/Trot class cannot also show in a three-gaited (Canter) class.
- ❖ Youth entering in a Versatility Class must be at least second year Junior Fair horse Exhibitors.*
- ❖ Equine Royalty horsemanship will be a 2 gaited class to accommodate different types of horses.
- ❖ Equine King/Queen contestants are eligible to show in both their horsemanship class and the Equine King/Queen Horsemanship class.
