December 1 – Final date for new club approval, club name approval, and club EIN.

January 15 – All Cross County Line request forms due. Only requests that meet Ohio 4-H policy will be approved.

January 18 at 7:00-9:00pm, 24 at 10:00am-noon, or 29 at 6:00-8:00pm – Attend one Club Advisor Update

February 1 – On-line 4-H Enrollments Due for bonus honor club points

- ✓ Advisors received an email from us on 11/16/23 with instructions for re-enrollment. Completing this will include your annual Standards of Behavior form.
- ☑ Families will receive an email from us on 11/16/23 with instructions for member reenrollment. All members need to decide on projects <u>before</u> re-enrolling.
- ✓ New members should go to: www.pickaway.osu.edu for Instructions on enrolling on-line. New families will need to decide on their projects before they are able to enroll. They can do this by reviewing the Family Guide or on 4-H Project Central
- ☑ All clubs: Complete the **4-H Chartering Checklist**.
- ☑ Update and Turn in <u>UPDATED</u> Ohio Club Constitution (signed by members) and By-Laws (optional but recommended) for Honor Club points.
- ☑ Turn in Club Program for Honor Club points.
- ☑ Submit your 4-H County Membership Fee \$10.00 per member made payable to the 4-H Committee, payment must accompany enrollment form. Should be a club check or bank check. No Cash check or money orders only. (Do not complete your check before arrival. We will run a current membership list when you arrive.)

- February 15 All 4-H Enrollments Due! See required list above. Only project changes may be made after this date.
- **Feb/March** Turn in project order form for your club. Make payment when order is picked up. Allow at least 24 hours for your books to be pulled.
- March 1 Deadline for Project Changes
 - ☐ Changes cannot be made through the on-line system. Contact the office no later than 4:30 pm on March 1 with project additions or deletions.
- April 15-May 15 Junior Fair Livestock On-line Entries made (except horses and dogs)
- **April 20 Bonus Honor Club points for QA completion –** must include all required club members and proof of completion.
- May 1 EquiSTEP Training must be complete for all horse exhibitors.
- May 1 All Quality Assurance Training must be complete. Proof of completion due by May 2.
- May 1 Jr. Fair Entries due from Members with Horse and Dog projects
- May Organizational Advisors will receive Jr. Fair entry club list. Review and confirm or make updates to Sale Committee before June 1.
- May 31 Jr. Fair Applications due for King/Queen, Princess & Equine Royalty Contests
- June 13-15 Set up your 4-H club booth all booths 8' wide, 4 ' deep & free-standing
- June 21 Pick-up Buyer Thank You placards from Sale Committee before the Livestock Sale and distribute them to your members.
- June 23 Take down your 4-H club booth
- August 5 Turn in: Advisor Grade Sheets, Honor Club Scoresheets, Officer Books (Secretary, Treasurer & Historian), Friend of 4-H Nominations, Yearly Financial Summary, and club audit items (for those in 2024 rotation).
- Sept. 23 Attend the Pickaway County Leader Recognition Banquet
- Nov. 15 Pick up club packets for 2025. (Tentative date. Packets will not be ready early (2))
