- Horse Packets were distributed a month ago. They contain a lot of information and all the required forms that need to be completed and returned to the Extension Office by 4:30 pm on **May 3**. Be sure you include your color photos and have signed up for all of your classes.

If we receive patterns from the judge we will post those there as well. It is up to each judge each year to decide to share patterns.

- The Senior Fair Board has generously scheduled three open horse work-outs at the fairgrounds. The final one this month will take place on **April 25** from 3:00-6:00 pm. Cloverleaf Saddle & Spurs 4-H club invites you to participate in their canned/non-perishable food drive by bringing items that afternoon to donate. In addition, remember to have a parent present to sign a waiver.
- Livestock Skillathon Judging – will take place on **June 10 and 11**. A schedule will be posted next month. Skillathon is required for all 4-H and FFA exhibitors taking any market animal, breeding animal, horse, or dog obedience/showmanship project to the fair. Early Judging is **June 2** by appointment. No late judging is permitted.
