## A FEW THINGS TO KNOW:

- The 4-H Dog Achievement Program, DAP is a self-directed, non-competitive project. Members do not attend a judging. Record keeping is completed on-line.
- Pickaway County has a 4-H Dog Key Leader who holds dog work-outs at the fairgrounds twice a month in March, April and May. All are welcome!
- All 201 Dog project members will receive a packet of information by mail April 1. Complete packet must be returned by May 1.
- Any dog exhibiting unsafe or threatening behavior at any time before, during, or after judging will be removed from the Fairgrounds. Muzzles are not permitted.
- Dogs may not be left unattended or taken around any areas of the fairgrounds except the show area. Dogs must be leashed except in the ring during judging.
