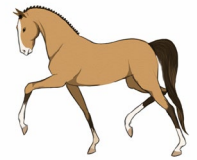




## 2021 Pickaway County Skillathon Schedule June 10 & 11 at Heritage Hall-Fairgrounds



Skillathon Judging is Pickaway County's method of project judging for all members taking beef, sheep, swine, dairy, goat, rabbit (except pet rabbit), poultry, horse (except Horseless Horse), dogs (except You & Your Dog), and llama projects. **4-H members must complete skillathon judging in order to complete their projects.** 4-H and FFA members must attend skillathon in order to exhibit at county or state fair (per Sr Fair Board October 2018). Completed 4-H record books must be brought to judging. FFA members must print and bring complete record book from AET.

A club/chapter schedule is below. Please come during your group's scheduled time. The times are strongly encouraged to keep traffic flowing smoothly. Your club/chapter's scheduled time is strongly recommended; however, members may come during the open times if they are unable to make their scheduled club time.

Advisors, parents, family, and friends of 4-H & FFA: We need volunteers for Thursday & Friday! Please call the Extension office 740-474-7534 to sign up for a shift. Having all stations filled with volunteers keeps this event running smoothly.

If members cannot attend judging on June 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup>, a pre-judging day has been set for **Wednesday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> from 9:00 am - 3:00 pm** by appointment. Contact the Extension office to schedule a pre-judging appointment. There will be **NO LATE JUDGING OR MAKE-UP JUDGING. If a member has not been judged by 8:00 pm on Friday, June 11<sup>th</sup>, that member will not be eligible to show at the fair.**

Members are required to follow the same dress code policy as for special interest judging: They "may wear shorts and open toed shoes, but must wear a shirt with no midriff showing, the torso must be completely covered." Members participating in the skillathon should treat this experience as a valued educational experience that should be taken seriously. We want members to develop communication and interview skills, including personal presentation. Inappropriate attire includes ball uniforms (clean or dirty), work uniforms, dirty work clothes, and tops with spaghetti straps. There are restrooms in the building if members need to change their clothing either to or from work or a sporting event. Please emphasize to your members the importance of personal presentation.

As of now, masks are required for all. Members should not shake hands. Hand sanitizing stations will be utilized before each station. Parents are asked to wait outside the judging area to decrease numbers in the building.
